

Position Description - Local and Global Outreach Internship

Summer 2019 10 weeks (June – August timeframe)

Purpose: To provide a college-level student who is pursuing a ministry career with a hands-on learning experience in international and local outreach ministries. The internship will focus on leadership development and real-world engagement through ministry endeavors at KSC.

Position Responsibilities:

- Devote 35 hours a week, on average, to ministry involvement
- Serve in the areas of both the Local Outreach Co-mission and the Missions Co-mission
- Help in the planning and execution of Bless Week if possible
- Assist in ministry preparation tasks for one or more short-term international missions trips; participate in a trip if possible
- Visit and learn about the work of our various LOC partners and engage with them where appropriate
- Develop communications pieces (in conjunction with Susanna Allen) to relay important information from the LOC and MC to the congregation
- Serve regularly with the Agape English and Once More ministry program
- Assist with King Street's involvement in the Chambersburg Project if possible
- Produce a ministry fair (or prepare the required components) to take place at the close of the internship or shortly thereafter
- Help community promotion of Celebrate Recovery and possibly assist with CR in other ways
- Read 2 books pertinent to community ministry and interact with staff on the material

Compensation: 35 hours a week at \$7.25 / hr - total of \$2537.50; costs paid for missions trip if applicable
