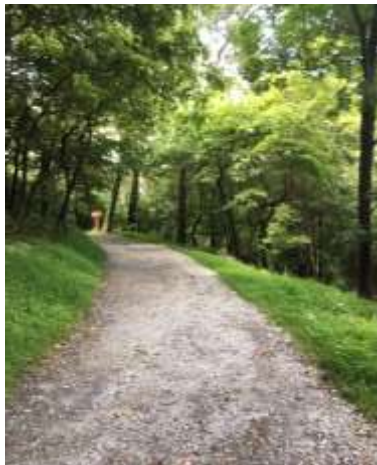
Antietam Battlefield

- Antietam Battlefield in Sharpsburg, MD – We will watch a film, and then a step-on-guide will join us on the 2 hour mini-bus tour of the battlefield.
- Next will be lunch at “Bonnie’s at the Red Byrd” café in Keedysville, MD. Lunch will be at your own expense.
- After lunch we will drive to Washington Monument State Park in Middletown, MD. This is the first Washington Monument ever built in the nation. There is a short 15 minute-ish walk, depending on how long you linger as you read information signs about George Washington along the way (and a couple resting spots). The walk is mostly level with a slight incline. At the top, outside the monument, there is a beautiful view of parts of Maryland and Pennsylvania.
- Those who desire may climb up the narrow steps inside the monument for an even better view. The total steps in the monument are probably about 3 flights of stairs. We will need to go up in small groups as there is not much space inside or at the top.
- Bring an umbrella if there is chance of rain and wear walking shoes.

**Cost:** \$22 a person includes transportation, step-on-guide, and admission for Antietam and the Washington Monument State Park. (Lunch is at your own expense)
