Please include a note with the check that includes: your name, address, all phone numbers where you may be reached, e-mail (if you check it often), check amount, date, and for which event(s) you are paying.

3. You are officially signed up when deposits are received: Day trip---\$10; Overnight Trip - \$50.
4. **Cancellation Policy:** If you need to cancel after signing up, call the above number immediately as there may be people on the waiting list. The final sign up due date/final payment due date and the cancellation date are all the same date. There is no refund of deposits or payments after this date. If you have to cancel AFTER this date, you will need to find a replacement unless there is someone on the waiting list. If you have an emergency that morning, call as early as possible (or up to 1 hour-ish before departure time) so we do not wait for you.
5. For overnight trips, if you desire trip insurance, you will need to acquire it on your own. There are Triple A brochures available. To qualify, you must sign up for insurance immediately after signing up for a trip.

7. **All trips will depart from Weis parking lot on Wayne Avenue in Chambersburg.** Arrive **earlier** than the "departure time" so that we can depart on time and get to the activity on time.
