**PRESUMPTIVE DEATH PETITION**

Petitioner asks the court to summon a jury to establish the presumption of death of the missing person named above. Petitioner states as follows:

1. I am interested in establishing the missing person's presumption of death because:  
I am the named executor of their will and estate  
(relationship to deceased or official capacity)
2. The event that likely led to death took place at or near the following city or location in Alaska:  
Pelican, Alaska
3. After due and diligent search, the missing person named above has not been found. The search is described in paragraph 4 below.
4. The following circumstances lead me to believe said missing person is dead:  
Eric Bealer left a detailed suicide note and instructions for their property after his and his wife's deaths in the late summer/early fall of 2018. Those documents are attached. The suicide was investigated by the Alaska Troopers. A report from the troopers is pending. The report has been requested. It is case number AK-18072470. The missing person left specific instructions that they do not want to be found and are unlikely to be found.
