

# SILVER LAKE RESERVOIR COMPLEX IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS



The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) is committed to being a good neighbor to the communities we serve. After completion of construction work at the Silver Lake Reservoir Complex and after receiving feedback from members of the community in and around the Silver Lake area, LADWP has responded to requests from the public with a series of improvements.

In partnership with Councilmembers David Ryu, 4th District, and Mitch O'Farrell, 13th District, LADWP is opening up access along the crest of Silver Lake Dam to create a walkway from Silver Lake Boulevard to West Silver Lake Drive, as well as opening up access adjacent to Ivanhoe Reservoir as a publicly accessible walkway. LADWP also plans to install a modular office unit within the Silver Lake Reservoir Complex to serve as office space for LADWP staff supporting the replacement of aging infrastructure and the delivery of large capital improvement projects in order to better serve the citizens of Los Angeles.

The following projects are either underway or in the planning stages to improve the operation and aesthetics of both Silver Lake and Ivanhoe Reservoirs.

## Silver Lake Dam Walkway

Fall 2017 – Winter 2018

The Silver Lake Dam Walkway will be accessible via existing gates on either side of the dam, with 8-foot-tall fencing along the access paths and 4-foot-tall fencing along the crest of the dam. Construction is ongoing with an anticipated completion in Winter 2018. Construction hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

## Ivanhoe Walkway

Spring 2018 – Fall 2018

The Ivanhoe Walkway will have two access points from West

Silver Lake Drive:

- Just south of Tesla Avenue
- North of Hawick Street

Eight-foot-tall fencing will be installed along the access paths and 4-foot-tall fencing will be installed along the side facing the reservoir. Before construction, some trees along the fence and pathway will have to be trimmed and two removed for safety and construction considerations. Design completion is anticipated by January 2018.

## Modular Office

Spring 2018 – Spring 2019

One 60-by-60-foot modular office will be installed just east of Silver Lake, within LADWP property. Prior to installation a foundation will be constructed and water, power and sewer connections will be made. When complete, 25-30 employees will report to the modular office. Parking for both personal and LADWP vehicles will be provided at the site. Construction hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

## Next Steps

Master Planning process led by the Bureau of Engineering and funded by LADWP will begin in 2018. The Master Plan will include community input on the future passive use of Silver Lake Reservoir.
