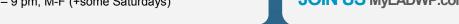


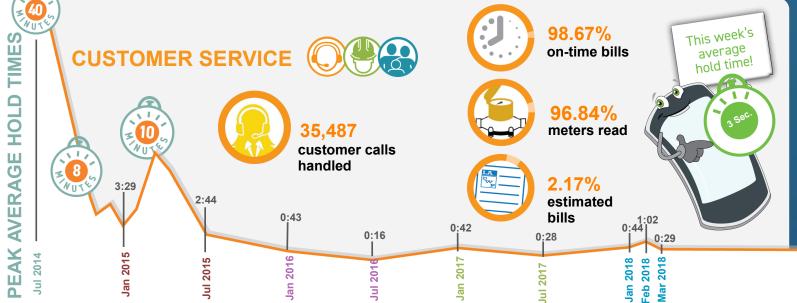

Service Interruptions

99.95% of customers experienced NO SERVICE INTERRUPTIONS.

For the week, there were **17** main leaks and **340** service interruptions.

Free Water-Saving Devices

LADWP customers can receive free water-saving devices by visiting one of our Customer Service Centers. These devices include bathroom and kitchen faucet aerators, which save about 900 gallons of water per year, and low-flow showerheads, which save up to 1 gallon per minute or over 5,300 gallons per year. From July 2017 through March 2018, LADWP gave away 19,141 aerators and 19,779 showerheads, saving water for approximately 1,155 homes annually.

Benedict Canyon Pipeline Replacement

To improve water supply reliability and fire protection capabilities, LADWP forces will begin a major pipeline replacement project in Benedict Canyon along Benedict Canyon Drive and Liebe Drive. Benedict Canyon Drive will be closed for the duration of the 7-month water reliability project to replace a mile of aging pipeline beginning May 1 and continuing through November 30. A press event took place April 26 with LADWP, the Los Angeles Fire Department and Los Angeles Department of Transportation to explain the construction project and traffic plans to accommodate commuters while the road is closed.

CUSTOMER SERVICE

POWER ____ Outages

95.15% customers experienced NO OUTAGES
For the week, there were **298** outage incidents, affecting **72,659** customers, including:

- 17 full and partial circuit outages that affected 13,737 customers mostly in Sun Valley, Larchmont, South Park, Palms, and Rancho Park
- 29 transformer outages that affected 446 customers mostly in Studio City, Woodland Hills, Vermont Square, Hollywood, and Watts.

Solar Incentive Program (SIP)

SIP, LADWP's net-meter solar program, offers incentives to offset the cost of installing a solar rooftop system at a home or business.

- As of April 23, 2018, approximately 227.7 megawatts (MW) from 30,818 solar installations have been incentivized through \$313.7 million in rebates, and put in service since the program began in 1999. Within LADWP's service area, there is a total of 257.6 MW from 34,532 customer-owned net-meter photovoltaic solar systems.
- During the week, SIP staff confirmed 71 incentive reservations and processed each within one day's time. Calls to the Solar Hotline were answered within 24 hours.

Free LEDs Help Light Up L.A.

LADWP's second LED distribution to all 1.5 million electric customers continued during the week. As of April 22, a total 400,000 LEDs had been delivered to communities through Los Angeles. By replacing two 75-watt incandescent or CFL lamps with the two 12-watt LED bulbs they receive, our customers can expect to save a combined 138 kilowatt-hours annually for the life of the bulbs, estimated to last nearly 23 years. Customers who make the switch can also save up to \$476 in electric costs over the lifetime of those two LEDs. So far the residential lighting distribution is expected to save up to 41,400 megawatt-hours annually for up to 23 years.

Commercial Customer Rebates

LADWP continues to assist its commercial customers in saving energy and money. During the week of April 13-19 2018, a total of 5,866,496 kilowatt-hours were saved through the Commercial Lighting Incentives Program and the Custom Performance Program. That amount of energy savings reduces greenhouse gas emissions equivalent to avoiding over 3,000 metric tons per year.
