




# AP Psychology 2020-2021

Use headings or numbers to ensure I understand which part you are answering. Please ensure your answer is typed and double spaced when you turn this in! It may be submitted either electronically, or in person. (Depending upon circumstances.)

1. Description of design/setup of the study: How was the study conducted? What did the researchers do?

2. Significance of the study to the understanding of psychology: What were the results of the study? What did it prove about human behavior/mental processes? Did it go against any previous theories?

3. Criticisms/Subsequent Research: Which of the criticisms stated do you agree with most? Explain. Do you have any criticisms of your own to add? What other research has been done to follow up on this study? (Note: not all studies will have clear criticisms. Make note of that in your response and fully discuss the subsequent research. THINK about it!)

4. Applications: How does this study relate to you? Have you experienced/seen something similar? Can you think of an important current event that relates? \*you do not have to answer all of the questions as long as one is discussed in detail. It is not enough to simply state that it doesn't relate to you. Be creative in your thought processes. Nothing in Psychology is simple.

5. Surprises: What did you learn from reading about this study? What surprised you? What intrigued you? Did this study give you more questions than answers?
