- Be able to give a 10 minute talk on a topic picked at random.
- Share a strong testimony and conviction of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and Joseph Smith.
- Give a summary of the 5 lessons from Preach my Gospel
- Must have finished their Personal Progress by age 16.
- Must have "The Relief Society Declaration" & Young Women's theme memorized.

Physical Fitness:

- Walk carrying 30 Book of Mormons in 1 arm 100 yards (without cutting corners).
- Run from one door to the next in under 7 seconds.
- Be able to ride a bike in a skirt.
- As depicted in this video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ASO4gG187VI>, these sister missionaries showed creativity and talent with teaching the gospel in a unique way. After receiving her call to serve, the sister missionary should teach a lesson in a creative way in her mission language.

Other Requirements:

- Must be able to style hair, and apply makeup in under 20 minutes
- Must be proficient in average (or better) social skills and communication.
- Be able to give a handshake with at least 10lb of squeeze pressure.
- Any prospective missionary must pass a rigorous Facebook background check.
 - Bishops are encouraged to watch for any misconduct or content contrary to church doctrines including immodest selfies, foul language or gestures, pictures of boyfriend / girlfriend kissing, etc.
- Must be able to sew a Parallel Button on by hand in 1 minute or less
- Must be First-Aid and CPR certified.
- Be able to hem Elders' pants.
