

# The DRAG BIG Method



Method	Explanation	Example
<b>DO</b>	Do the activity planned for the day.	Making pillowcases with animal prints on them.
<b>RECALL</b>	<p>Gather the group close together and wait for everyone's attention.</p> <p>Ask, "What did we just do?" (It may be necessary for you to have people raise their hands to that they do not talk over each other. )</p> <p>This is a simple recall of what happened.</p>	"We colored animals on pillowcases."
<b>ANALYZE</b>	Have the group think about what skills were needed to accomplish the task just completed or what the activity reminds them of.	<p>Who's ever seen a live elephant?</p> <p>Who's been to the zoo?</p>
<b>GENERALIZE</b>	This section applies that the group talked about in the analyze section to their daily lives.	Who has a pet? What kind? Are they a lot of work to take care of?
<b>BIBLICIZE</b>	This step relates the topic of discussion to the Bible.	Today's lesson talks about Moses. He was a shepherd who also took care of animals. What animals did he take care of?
<b>GENERALIZE (or GODIFY)</b>	This step applies the Biblicize section to our daily lives as Christians.	<p>Just like we take care of our pets, who takes care of us?</p> <p>God promises to always be with us, so when you go to bed each night with this pillowcase, remember that God is always with you. God will take care of you and loves you.</p>
