1 Amend the State, Veterans, & Military Affairs Committee Report, dated  
2 March 28, 2019, page 1, strike lines 3 through 24 and substitute:  
3 **""SECTION 1. Legislative declaration.** (1) The general  
4 assembly finds and declares that:  
5 (a) The state of Colorado has a longstanding respect for and  
6 support of the Tenth Amendment to the United States constitution; and  
7 (b) The state of Colorado is the proper and natural repository of  
8 the laws and rules that affect the residents of the state and that, in every  
9 practical circumstance, the laws of the state prevail, notwithstanding the  
10 inherent cooperative relationship with federal government agencies,  
11 including the Food and Drug Administration, the Department of  
12 Agriculture, the Department of Defense, the National Aeronautics and  
13 Space Administration, the Federal Aviation Administration, the  
14 Environmental Protection Agency, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,  
15 Firearms and Explosives, National Railroad Passenger Corporation  
16 (Amtrak), the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, the Army  
17 Corps of Engineers, the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection, the  
18 Bureau of Labor, the Bureau of Reclamation, the Census Bureau, the  
19 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Central Intelligence Agency,  
20 Central Command, Citizenship and Immigration Services, the United  
21 States Coast Guard, the United States Army, the Court of Appeals,  
22 Customs and Border Protection, Department of Commerce, Department  
23 of Defense, Department of Education, Department of Energy, Department
