1 Amend printed bill, page 20, line 15, after the period insert "THE LAW
2 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER SHALL NOT TAKE POSSESSION OF ANY FIREARM IN
3 THE RESIDENCE THAT IS THE PROPERTY OF ANY OTHER PERSON LIVING AT
4 THE RESIDENCE. IF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TAKES POSSESSION OF
5 A FIREARM THAT IS THE PROPERTY OF A PERSON LIVING AT THE RESIDENCE
6 WHO IS NOT THE RESPONDENT, AND THE PERSON IS INJURED OR DIES
7 DURING THE TIME IN WHICH THE PERSON'S FIREARM WAS IN THE
8 POSSESSION OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, AND THE PERSON'S
9 INJURY OR DEATH COULD HAVE BEEN PREVENTED IF THE PERSON HAD
10 POSSESSION OF THE FIREARM, THE PERSON HAS A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST
11 THE STATE OF COLORADO. GOVERNMENTAL IMMUNITY IS EXPRESSLY
12 WAIVED FOR A SUIT PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (1)."
