1 Amend the Transportation and Local Government Committee Report,
2 dated March 6, 2019, page 1, strike line 13 and substitute:

3 "AND ADMINISTERED.

4 (III) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION
5 OR OF PART 14 OF ARTICLE 1 OF TITLE 29:

6 (A) A LOCAL MINIMUM WAGE LAW MUST PERMIT AN APPLICANT
7 FOR EMPLOYMENT OR AN EMPLOYEE OF AN EMPLOYER TO CHOOSE TO
8 WAIVE THE CONSTITUTIONAL MINIMUM WAGE RIGHT AND NEGOTIATE A
9 WAGE THAT IS AGREEABLE TO THE APPLICANT OR EMPLOYEE AND THE
10 EMPLOYER; AND

11 (B) AN EMPLOYER SHALL POST AND MAINTAIN A NOTICE TO
12 INFORM APPLICANTS AND EMPLOYEES THAT THEY HAVE THE RIGHT TO
13 NEGOTIATE WAGES AS SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBSECTION (3)(c)(III). THE
14 NOTICE MUST BE CONSPICUOUSLY POSTED AT A WORK LOCATION."."
