HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend the State, Veterans, & Military Affairs Committee Report, dated
2 April 2, 2019, page 5, strike lines 14 through 19 and substitute:

3 "Page 30 of the printed bill, strike lines 22 through 27 and substitute:

4 "(a) IN A COUNTY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1-5-102.9 (1)(a)(I) OR
5 (1)(a)(II):

6 (I) DURING THE PERIOD FROM THE FIFTEENTH DAY BEFORE THE
7 ELECTION TO THE DAY BEFORE THE ELECTION, VOTER SERVICE AND
8 POLLING CENTERS MUST BE OPEN CONTINUOUSLY AT LEAST FROM 8 A.M.
9 TO 5 P.M.; EXCEPT THAT VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTERS ARE NOT
10 REQUIRED TO BE OPEN ON SUNDAYS OR ON THE FIRST SATURDAY OF THIS
11 PERIOD.

12 (II) ON ELECTION DAY, VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTERS
13 MUST BE OPEN CONTINUOUSLY FROM 6 A.M. TO 8 P.M.

14 (b) IN ALL OTHER COUNTIES:

15 (I) DURING THE PERIOD FROM THE FIFTEENTH DAY BEFORE THE
16 ELECTION TO THE DAY BEFORE THE ELECTION, VOTER SERVICE AND
17 POLLING CENTERS MUST BE OPEN DURING THE NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS
18 FOR THE COUNTY; EXCEPT THAT VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTERS
19 ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE OPEN ON SUNDAYS OR ON THE FIRST SATURDAY
20 OF THIS PERIOD, AND MUST BE OPEN FOR AT LEAST FOUR HOURS
21 CONTINUOUSLY ON THE SECOND SATURDAY OF THIS PERIOD.

22 (II) ON ELECTION DAY, VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTERS
23 MUST BE OPEN CONTINUOUSLY FROM 6 A.M. TO 8 P.M."

24 Page 31 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 3."
