HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Public Health Care & Human Services.

HB19-1308 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 3, strike "PLAN." and substitute "PLAN,
2 AND SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS OR FEDERAL
3 FUNDING."

4 Page 5, after line 5 insert:

5 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 19-1-102, **add** (1.9)
6 as follows:

7 **19-1-102. Legislative declaration.** (1.9) THE FEDERAL "FAMILY
8 FIRST PREVENTION SERVICES ACT" WAS ENACTED ON FEBRUARY 9, 2018.
9 IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE FEDERAL "FAMILY
10 FIRST PREVENTION SERVICES ACT", THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT
11 IT IS NECESSARY TO UPDATE CURRENT STATUTES TO ENABLE COLORADO
12 TO PROVIDE ENHANCED SUPPORT TO CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND THEIR
13 FAMILIES IN ORDER TO PREVENT FOSTER CARE PLACEMENTS. THE STATE
14 DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT THE UPDATED PROVISIONS IN SECTIONS
15 19-1-103, 19-1-115, 19-3-208, AND 19-3-308 UTILIZING FOSTER CARE
16 PREVENTION SERVICES AND QUALIFIED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT
17 PROGRAMS WHEN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT APPROVES COLORADO'S
18 FIVE-YEAR TITLE IV-E PREVENTION PLAN, AND SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE
19 GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS OR FEDERAL FUNDING."

20 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

21 Page 11, strike lines 12 through 27.

22 Page 12, strike lines 1 through 3 and substitute:

23 "SECTION 11. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 27-66-110 as
24 follows:

25 **27-66-110. Trauma-informed care standards of approval.** THE
26 OFFICE OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SHALL ESTABLISH CARE STANDARDS AND
27 AN APPROVAL PROCESS THAT A QUALIFIED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT
28 PROGRAM, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 26-6-102 (30.5), MUST MEET TO ENSURE
29 THAT QUALIFIED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAMS HAVE A
30 TRAUMA-INFORMED TREATMENT MODEL THAT ADDRESSES THE NEEDS OF
31 CHILDREN AND YOUTH WITH SERIOUS EMOTIONAL OR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
32 DISORDERS OR DISTURBANCES."

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
