

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

SB19-218 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 6, after line 25 insert:

2 **"SECTION 3. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal
3 year, \$114,007 is appropriated to the department of public health and
4 environment for use by the center for health and environmental
5 information. This appropriation is from the medical marijuana program
6 cash fund created in section 25-1.5-106 (16)(a), C.R.S. To implement this
7 act, the center may use this appropriation as follows:

8 (a) \$14,007 for personal services related to the medical marijuana
9 registry, which amount is based on an assumption that the department will
10 require an additional 0.2 FTE; and

11 (b) \$100,000 for operating expenses related to the medical
12 marijuana registry.

13 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$560,143 is appropriated to
14 the department of regulatory agencies. This appropriation is from the
15 division of professions and occupations cash fund created in section 24-
16 34-105 (2)(b)(I), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may use
17 this appropriation as follows:

18 (a) \$24,687 for use by the division of professions and occupations
19 for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the
20 division will require an additional 0.4 FTE; and

21 (b) \$535,456 for the purchase of legal services.

22 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$535,456 is appropriated to
23 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
24 received from the department of regulatory agencies under subsection
25 (2)(b) of this section and is based on an assumption that the department
26 of law will require an additional 2.9 FTE. To implement this act, the
27 department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for
28 the department of regulatory agencies."

29 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

30 Page 1, line 104, strike "AGENCIES." and substitute "AGENCIES AND
31 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
