

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Finance.

SB19-218 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 6, after line 13 insert:

2 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1.5-110, amend
3 (2) and (3) as follows:

4 **25-1.5-110. Monitor health effects of marijuana - report. (2)**

5 (a) The department shall appoint a panel of health care professionals with
6 expertise in, ~~cannabinoid physiology to monitor the relevant information~~
7 BUT NOT LIMITED TO, NEUROSCIENCE, EPIDEMIOLOGY, TOXICOLOGY,
8 CANNABIS PHYSIOLOGY, AND CANNABIS QUALITY CONTROL TO FURTHER
9 DIRECT POLICY. Notwithstanding section 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), the panel
10 shall provide a report by January 31, 2015, and every two years thereafter
11 to the state board of health, the department of revenue, and the general
12 assembly. The department shall make the report available on its website.
13 The panel shall establish criteria for studies to be reviewed, reviewing
14 studies and other data, and making recommendations, as appropriate, for
15 policies intended to protect consumers of marijuana or marijuana
16 products and the general public.

17 (b) IN ORDER TO ALLOW THE PUBLIC TO EVALUATE ANY CONFLICT
18 OF INTEREST AMONG THE PANEL, EACH PANELIST SHALL DISCLOSE ALL
19 FINANCIAL INTERESTS THE PANELIST HAS RELATED TO THE HEALTH CARE
20 INDUSTRY AND THE REGULATED MARIJUANA INDUSTRY. THE DISCLOSURES
21 MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE REPORT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION
22 (2)(a) OF THIS SECTION.

23 (3) The department may ~~collect Colorado-specific data that reports~~
24 ~~adverse health events involving marijuana use from the all-payer claims~~
25 ~~database, hospital discharge data, and behavioral risk factors~~ INQUIRE TO
26 COLLECT COLORADO-SPECIFIC DATA THAT INVOLVES HEALTH OUTCOMES
27 ASSOCIATED WITH CANNABIS FROM ALL-PAYER CLAIMS DATA, HOSPITAL
28 DISCHARGE DATA, AND AVAILABLE PEER-REVIEWED RESEARCH STUDIES."
