

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Finance.

SB19-224 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 62, line 4, strike "(4)" and substitute "(4); and
2 **add** (13)(c)".

3 Page 63, after line 11 insert:

4 "(13) (c) (I) AN OPTIONAL PREMISES CULTIVATION FACILITY THAT
5 HAS OBTAINED AN APPROVED CHANGE OF LOCATION FROM THE STATE
6 LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY OPERATE ONE LICENSE AT TWO
7 GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSITIONING
8 OPERATIONS FROM ONE LOCATION TO ANOTHER IF:

9 (A) THE TOTAL PLANTS CULTIVATED AT BOTH LOCATIONS DO NOT
10 EXCEED ANY PLANT COUNT LIMIT IMPOSED ON THE LICENSE BY THIS
11 ARTICLE 11 AND ANY RULES PROMULGATED BY THE STATE LICENSING
12 AUTHORITY;

13 (B) THE LICENSED PREMISES OF BOTH GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATIONS
14 COMPLY WITH ALL SURVEILLANCE, SECURITY, AND INVENTORY TRACKING
15 REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY THIS ARTICLE 11 AND ANY RULES
16 PROMULGATED BY THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY;

17 (C) BOTH THE TRANSFERRING LOCATION AND THE RECEIVING
18 LOCATION TRACK ALL PLANTS VIRTUALLY IN TRANSITION IN THE
19 SEED-TO-SALE TRACKING SYSTEM TO ENSURE PROPER TRACKING FOR
20 TAXATION AND TRACKING PURPOSES;

21 (D) OPERATION AT BOTH GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATIONS DOES NOT
22 EXCEED ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS, UNLESS FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN,
23 THE ONE-HUNDRED-EIGHTY-DAY DEADLINE MAY BE EXTENDED FOR AN
24 ADDITIONAL ONE HUNDRED TWENTY DAYS; AND

25 (E) THE OPTIONAL PREMISES CULTIVATION FACILITY LICENSEE
26 OBTAINS THE PROPER STATE PERMIT AND LOCAL PERMIT OR LICENSE. IF
27 THE CHANGE OF LOCATION IS WITHIN THE SAME LOCAL JURISDICTION, THE
28 LICENSEE MUST FIRST OBTAIN A TRANSITION PERMIT FROM THE STATE
29 LICENSING AUTHORITY AND, IF REQUIRED BY THE LOCAL JURISDICTION, A
30 TRANSITION PERMIT OR OTHER FORM OF APPROVAL FROM THE LOCAL
31 LICENSING AUTHORITY. IF THE CHANGE OF LOCATION IS TO A DIFFERENT
32 LOCAL JURISDICTION, THE LICENSEE MUST FIRST OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM
33 THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY FOR THE LOCAL JURISDICTION WHERE

1 Page 63, line 13, strike "(3)" and substitute "(3); and **add** (12)(c)".

2 Page 63, after line 24 insert:

3 "(12) (c) (I) A RETAIL MARIJUANA CULTIVATION FACILITY THAT
4 HAS OBTAINED AN APPROVED CHANGE OF LOCATION FROM THE STATE
5 LICENSING AUTHORITY MAY OPERATE ONE LICENSE AT TWO
6 GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSITIONING
7 OPERATIONS FROM ONE LOCATION TO ANOTHER IF:

8 (A) THE TOTAL PLANTS CULTIVATED AT BOTH LOCATIONS DO NOT

23 WITHIN THE SAME LOCAL JURISDICTION, THE LICENSEE MUST FIRST OBTAIN
24 A TRANSITION PERMIT FROM THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY AND, IF
25 REQUIRED BY THE LOCAL JURISDICTION, A TRANSITION PERMIT OR OTHER
26 FORM OF APPROVAL FROM THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OR LOCAL
27 JURISDICTION. IF THE CHANGE OF LOCATION IS TO A DIFFERENT LOCAL
28 JURISDICTION, THE LICENSEE MUST FIRST OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM THE
29 LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OR LOCAL JURISDICTION WHERE IT INTENDS
30 TO LOCATE, A TRANSITION PERMIT FROM THE STATE LICENSING
31 AUTHORITY, AND, IF REQUIRED BY THE LOCAL JURISDICTION, A TRANSITION
32 PERMIT OR OTHER FORM OF APPROVAL FROM THE LOCAL LICENSING
33 AUTHORITY OR LOCAL JURISDICTION FOR THE LOCAL JURISDICTION WHERE
34 IT INTENDS TO LOCATE.
