

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

SB19-228 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 34, after line 1 insert:

2 **"SECTION 24. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2019-20 state fiscal
3 year, \$157,754 is appropriated to the department of human services for
4 use by the office of behavioral health. This appropriation is from the
5 general fund and is based on an assumption that the office will require an
6 additional 1.5 FTE. To implement this act, the office may use this
7 appropriation for the administration and evaluation expenses related to
8 the Charlie Hughes and Nathan Gauna opioid prevention grant program.

9 (2) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$2,000,000 is appropriated
10 to the youth opioid and substance use prevention fund created in section
11 27-80-103.5 (4), C.R.S. This appropriation is from the marijuana tax cash
12 fund created in section 39-28.8-501 (1), C.R.S. The department of human
13 services is responsible for the accounting related to this appropriation.

14 (3) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$997,754 is appropriated to
15 the department of human services for use by the office of behavioral
16 health. This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an
17 assumption that the office will require an additional 1.5 FTE. To
18 implement this act, the office may use this appropriation for the maternal
19 and child health pilot program.

20 (4) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$750,000 is appropriated to
21 the department of higher education for use by the regents of the university
22 of Colorado. This appropriation is from the marijuana tax cash fund
23 created in section 39-28.8-501 (1), C.R.S. To implement this act, the
24 regents may use this appropriation for allocation to the center for research
25 into substance use disorder prevention, treatment, and recovery support
26 strategies and the college of nursing.

27 (5) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$50,00 is appropriated to the
28 department of higher education. This appropriation is from the general
29 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation
30 for the college opportunity fund program to be used for limited purpose
31 fee-for-service contracts with state institutions.

32 (6) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$50,000 is appropriated to
33 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from
34 reappropriated funds received from the limited purpose fee-for-service
35 contracts with state institutions under subsection (6) of this section. To
36 implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the
37 regents of the university of Colorado for allocation to the center for
38 research into substance use disorder prevention, treatment, and recovery
39 support strategies.

40 (7) For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, \$2,000,000 is appropriated

1 to the department of public health and environment. This appropriation
2 is from the general fund. To implement this act, the office may use this
3 appropriation as follows:
4 (a) \$71,852 for use by the prevention services division for
5 administration, which amount is based on an assumption that the division
6 will require an additional 0.9 FTE;
7 (b) \$1,564,148 for distributions to local public health agencies;
8 and
9 (c) \$364,000 for personal services related to health statistics and
10 vital records."

14 Page 2, line 11, strike "PROGRAM." and substitute "PROGRAM; AND
15 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
