1 Amend revised bill, page 6, strike lines 25 through 27 and substitute:

2 "SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 19-1-129 as
3 follows:

4 19-1-129. Department - research authorized - prenatal
5 substance exposure - newborn and family outcomes - report. (1) THE
6 DEPARTMENT MAY CONDUCT RESEARCH AS RELATED TO THE DEFINITION
7 OF "ABUSE" IN SECTION 19-1-103 CONCERNING THE INCIDENCE OF
8 PRENATAL SUBSTANCE EXPOSURE AND RELATED NEWBORN AND FAMILY
9 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES OUTCOMES AS THE RESULT OF A MOTHER'S
10 LAWFUL AND UNLAWFUL INTAKE OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

11 (2) BEGINNING IN JANUARY 2021 AND EVERY TWO YEARS
12 THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT THE OUTCOMES OF ANY
13 RESEARCH CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION TO
14 THE JOINT HEALTH COMMITTEES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AS PART OF
15 ITS "STATE MEASUREMENT FOR ACCOUNTABLE, RESPONSIVE, AND
16 TRANSPARENT (SMART) GOVERNMENT ACT" PRESENTATION REQUIRED
17 BY SECTION 2-7-203."

18 Page 7, strike lines 1 through 15.

19 Page 22, line 2, strike "13 to 17" and substitute "14 to 18".

20 Page 22, line 3, strike "13 to 17" and substitute "14 to 18".

21 Page 1, line 104, strike "PHYSICIANS AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS" and
22 substitute "PRESCRIBERS".

23 Page 1, line 107, after "EXAMINERS" insert "AND CORONERS".

24 Page 1, line 108, after "PROGRAM;" insert "AUTHORIZING THE
25 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO CONDUCT SUBSTANCE USE
26 RESEARCH;"
