

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

SB19-249 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 5, after line 15, insert:

2 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-20-124, **amend**
3 (2) introductory portion as follows:

4 **44-20-124. Unlawful acts.** (2) It is unlawful for any person to act
5 as a motor vehicle dealer, manufacturer, distributor, wholesaler,
6 manufacturer representative, used motor vehicle dealer, buyer agent,
7 wholesale motor vehicle auction dealer, BUSINESS DISPOSER, or motor
8 vehicle salesperson unless the person has been duly licensed under this
9 part 1, except for:

10 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-20-128, **amend**
11 (2)(b) as follows:

12 **44-20-128. Penalty.** (2) (b) Any person who willfully violates
13 section 44-20-124 (2) by acting as a motor vehicle dealer, wholesaler,
14 used motor vehicle dealer, buyer agent, wholesale motor vehicle auction
15 dealer, BUSINESS DISPOSER, or motor vehicle salesperson without proper
16 authorization commits a class 3 misdemeanor and, upon conviction
17 thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than one thousand dollars
18 and a penalty of twenty-five hours of useful public service, neither of
19 which the court may suspend, for each separate offense; except that, if the
20 violator is a corporation, the corporation shall be punished by a fine of not
21 less than five thousand dollars nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars
22 for each separate offense. A second conviction for an individual shall be
23 punished by a fine of not less than five thousand dollars nor more than
24 twenty-five thousand dollars for each separate offense, which the court
25 may not suspend."
