4 20-163, AND EACH SCHOOL YEAR THEREAFTER, a".

5 Page 5, line 18, strike "on or after the dates specified in section 25-4-906
6 (4)" and substitute "~~on or after the dates specified in section 25-4-906~~
7 ~~(4)~~".

8 Page 7, line 9, strike "JANUARY 15, 2021," and substitute "JANUARY 15 OF
9 THE YEAR FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (4), AS
10 AMENDED BY SENATE BILL 20-163,".

11 Page 7, line 15, strike "JANUARY 31, 2021," and substitute "JANUARY 31
12 OF THE YEAR FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (4),
13 AS AMENDED BY SENATE BILL 20-163,".

14 Page 8, line 11, strike "FEBRUARY 15, 2021," and substitute "FEBRUARY
15 15 OF THE SCHOOL YEAR THAT COMMENCES AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE
16 OF THIS SUBSECTION (4), AS AMENDED BY SENATE BILL 20-163,".

17 Page 12, line 5, strike "JANUARY 1, 2021," and substitute "JANUARY 1 OF
18 THE YEAR FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (2.3), AS
19 ENACTED BY SENATE BILL 20-163,".

20 Page 17, line 5, strike "\$41,906" and substitute "\$40,953".

21 Page 17, line 8, strike "\$31,884" and substitute "\$30,931".

22 Page 17, strike lines 19 through 21 and substitute:

23 **"SECTION 10. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
24 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
25 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
26 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
27 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
28 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
29 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
30 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
31 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."
