1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 20, after line 23 insert:

2 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-14.3-202, **amend**
3 (2) as follows:

4 **8-14.3-202. Definitions.** As used in this part 2, unless the context
5 otherwise requires:

6 (2) "Apprenticeship" means an apprenticeship training program
7 registered with the United States department of ~~labor~~; LABOR'S office of
8 apprenticeship OR A STATE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM RECOGNIZED BY
9 THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT LABOR.

10 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-83-308, **amend**
11 (3)(a) as follows:

12 **8-83-308. Colorado state apprenticeship resource directory -**
13 **collection of apprenticeship program information - promotion of**
14 **public awareness - definitions.** (3) As used in this section, unless the
15 context otherwise requires:

16 (a) "Apprenticeship program" means a Colorado-based
17 apprenticeship training program that is registered with the United States
18 department of labor's office of apprenticeship OR AN APPRENTICESHIP
19 PROGRAM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 8-15.7-101 (4).

20 **SECTION 6.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-54-138, **amend**
21 (1)(b) and (1)(c)(II) as follows:

22 **22-54-138. Career development success program - created -**
23 **funding - report - definitions - repeal.** (1) As used in this section,
24 unless the context otherwise requires:

25 (b) "Construction industry apprenticeship program" means an
26 apprenticeship program registered with the office of apprenticeship in the
27 United States department of labor OR A STATE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM
28 RECOGNIZED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR that trains
29 individuals for careers in the construction industry.

30 (c) "Construction industry pre-apprenticeship program" means a
31 program or set of strategies that:

32 (II) Has a documented relationship with at least one
33 apprenticeship program registered with the office of apprenticeship in the
34 United States department of labor OR A STATE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM
35 RECOGNIZED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR; and

36 **SECTION 7.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-46.3-301, **amend**
37 (1) as follows:

38 **24-46.3-301. Definitions.** As used in this part 3, unless the
39 context otherwise requires:

1 (1) "Apprenticeship program" means a Colorado-based
2 apprenticeship training program that is registered with the office of
3 apprenticeship in the United States department of labor OR A STATE
4 APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM RECOGNIZED BY THE UNITED STATES
5 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

6 **SECTION 8.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-92-208, **amend**
7 (2)(b) as follows:

8 **24-92-208. Apprenticeship contribution rate.** (2) The amount
9 of the apprenticeship contribution will be set in accordance with the
10 apprenticeship contribution of the collective bargaining agreement of the
11 applicable trade in the geographic locality of the public project.
12 Contractors shall achieve compliance with this requirement by one of the
13 following options:

14 (b) Contractors that are not signatory to a collective bargaining
15 agreement but that are members of a multi-employer trade association that
16 sponsors an apprenticeship program registered with the United States
17 department of labor's employment and training administration OR
18 RECOGNIZED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR or directly
19 sponsor such a program for their own employees, shall pay the
20 determined apprenticeship contribution to that program or to a state
21 apprenticeship council registered with the United States department of
22 labor; or

23 **SECTION 9.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-93-105, **amend**
24 (3) introductory portion as follows:

25 **24-93-105. Integrated project delivery contracting process -**
26 **prequalification of participating entities - apprentice training.**

27 (3) Where an apprentice ~~training~~ program AS DEFINED IN SECTION
28 8-15.7-101 (4) OR certified by the office of apprenticeship located in the
29 employment and training administration in the United States department
30 of labor exists in the state, or a comparable program for the training of
31 apprentices is available in the state:

32 **SECTION 10.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 31-25-1305, **amend**
33 (3) introductory portion as follows:

34 **31-25-1305. Integrated project delivery contracting process -**
35 **prequalification of participating entities - apprentice training.**

36 (3) Where an apprentice ~~training~~ program AS DEFINED IN SECTION
37 8-15.7-101 (4) OR certified by the office of apprenticeship located in the
38 employment and training administration in the United States department
39 of labor exists in a county in which all or any portion of the municipality
40 is located, or a comparable program for the training of apprentices is
41 available in such county:

42 **SECTION 11.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 32-1-1805, **amend**
43 (3) introductory portion as follows:

1 **32-1-1805. Integrated project delivery contracting process -**
2 **prequalification of participating entities - apprentice training.**

3 (3) Where an apprentice ~~training~~ program AS DEFINED IN SECTION
4 8-15.7-101 (4) OR certified by the office of apprenticeship ~~located~~ in the
5 employment and training administration in the United States department
6 of labor exists in a county in which all or any portion of the special
7 district is located, or a comparable program for the training of apprentices
8 is available in such county:".
