1 Amend printed bill, page 12, line 6, before "(2)(a)" insert "(1) and".

2 Page 12, strike line 8 and substitute "- **definition.** (1) (a) As used in this  
3 part 6, "place of public accommodation" means any place of business  
4 engaged in any sales to the public and any place offering services,  
5 facilities, privileges, advantages, or accommodations to the public,  
6 including but not limited to any business offering wholesale or retail sales  
7 to the public; any place to eat, drink, sleep, or rest, or any combination  
8 thereof; any sporting or recreational area and facility; any public  
9 transportation facility; a barber shop, bathhouse, swimming pool, bath,  
10 steam or massage parlor, gymnasium, or other establishment conducted  
11 to serve the health, appearance, or physical condition of a person; a  
12 campsite or trailer camp; a dispensary, clinic, hospital, convalescent  
13 home, or other institution for the sick, ailing, aged, or infirm; a mortuary,  
14 undertaking parlor, or cemetery; an educational institution; or any public  
15 building, park, arena, theater, hall, auditorium, museum, library, exhibit,  
16 or public facility of any kind whether indoor or outdoor. "Place of public  
17 accommodation" shall not include a ~~church, synagogue, mosque, or other~~  
18 ~~place that is principally used for religious purposes~~ RELIGIOUS  
19 ORGANIZATION.

20 (b) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION" MEANS:

21 (I) A HOUSE OF WORSHIP, INCLUDING A CHURCH, SYNAGOGUE,  
22 SHRINE, MOSQUE, OR TEMPLE; AND

23 (II) A RELIGIOUS GROUP, CORPORATION, ASSOCIATION, SCHOOL OR  
24 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION, HOSPITAL, MINISTRY, ORDER, SOCIETY, OR  
25 SIMILAR ENTITY, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER IT IS INTEGRATED OR  
26 AFFILIATED WITH A CHURCH OR OTHER HOUSE OF WORSHIP, AS PROTECTED  
27 UNDER CURRENT FIRST AMENDMENT JURISPRUDENCE.

28 (2) (a) It is a discriminatory practice and unlawful for a".
