3	part 6:

- (a) (I) "Place of public accommodation" means any place of business engaged in any sales to the public and any place offering services, facilities, privileges, advantages, or accommodations to the public, including but not limited to:
  - (A) Any business offering wholesale or retail sales to the public;
- (B) Any place to eat, drink, sleep, or rest, or any combination thereof;
  - (C) Any sporting or recreational area and facility;
  - (D) Any public transportation facility;
- (E) A barber shop, bathhouse, swimming pool, bath, steam or massage parlor, gymnasium, or other establishment conducted to serve the health, appearance, or physical condition of a person;
  - (F) A campsite or trailer camp;
- (G) A dispensary, clinic, hospital, convalescent home, or other institution for the sick, ailing, aged, or infirm;
  - (H) A mortuary, undertaking parlor, or cemetery;
  - (I) An educational institution; or
- (J) Any public building, park, arena, theater, hall, auditorium, museum, library, exhibit, or public facility of any kind whether indoor or outdoor.
- (II) "Place of public accommodation" shall DOES not include a church, synagogue, mosque, or other place OWNED OR OPERATED BY A RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION that is principally used for religious purposes.
- (b) "Religious purposes" includes religious worship as described in section 39-3-106 (2) and should be interpreted in the same manner as interpreted under said section.
  - (2) (a) It is a discriminatory practice and unlawful for a".
