

SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 5, strike lines 25 through 27.

2 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 4 and substitute:

3 "(10) (a) SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN
4 SUBSECTIONS (10)(b) AND (10)(c) OF THIS SECTION, "REUSABLE
5 CARRYOUT BAG" MEANS A CARRYOUT BAG THAT IS DESIGNED AND
6 MANUFACTURED FOR AT LEAST ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE USES AND
7 CAN CARRY AT LEAST TWENTY-TWO POUNDS OVER A DISTANCE OF ONE
8 HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE FEET.

9 (b) A REUSABLE CARRYOUT BAG THAT IS MADE FROM PLASTIC FILM
10 MUST BE AT LEAST TWO AND ONE-FOURTH MILS, DESIGNED AND
11 MANUFACTURED FOR AT LEAST ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE USES, AND
12 CAN CARRY AT LEAST TWENTY-TWO POUNDS OVER A DISTANCE OF ONE
13 HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE FEET AS MEASURED ACCORDING TO ASTM
14 STANDARD D6988-13, "STANDARD GUIDE FOR DETERMINATION OF
15 THICKNESS OF PLASTIC FILM TEST SPECIMENS", OR ITS SUCCESSOR
16 STANDARD.

17 (c) A REUSABLE CARRYOUT BAG MADE WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY
18 FROM PLASTIC, INCLUDING POLYETHYLENE, WOVEN OR NONWOVEN
19 NYLON, POLYPROPYLENE, OR POLYETHYLENE-TEREPHTHALATE, MUST
20 MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

21 (I) ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 2024, THE REUSABLE CARRYOUT
22 BAG MUST BE MADE FROM A MINIMUM OF TWENTY PERCENT
23 POST-CONSUMER RECYCLED CONTENT; AND

24 (II) ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 2026, THE REUSABLE CARRYOUT
25 BAG MUST BE MADE FROM A MINIMUM OF FORTY PERCENT
26 POST-CONSUMER RECYCLED CONTENT.

27 (d) "REUSABLE CARRYOUT BAG" DOES NOT INCLUDE BAGS MADE".
