HB21-1199 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, after line 14 insert:

- **"6-1-1302. Legislative declaration.** (1) The General assembly Hereby finds and determines that:
- (a) DIGITAL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT PROVIDES SIGNIFICANT SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC BENEFITS TO THE STATE AND ITS CITIZENS;
- (b) Original equipment manufacturers utilize policies and practices that require owners to use an original equipment manufacturer or its authorized repair provider to repair digital electronic equipment, thus making consumers dependent on the original equipment manufacturers and their authorized repair providers for repairs, regardless of the cost or distance required to get such repairs performed;
- (c) THERE IS A COMPELLING NEED TO CURTAIL THESE POLICIES AND PRACTICES TO PROVIDE CONSUMERS WITH A CHOICE REGARDING THE REPAIR OF THEIR DIGITAL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, WHETHER BY ALLOWING A CONSUMER TO PERFORM THE REPAIRS OR TO CONTRACT WITH AN INDEPENDENT REPAIR PROVIDER TO REPAIR THE DIGITAL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT;
- (d) TO GIVE CONSUMERS A CHOICE REGARDING WHO REPAIRS THEIR DIGITAL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURERS SHOULD BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE CONSUMERS AND INDEPENDENT REPAIR PROVIDERS WITH THE INFORMATION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE REPAIRS, INCLUDING GIVING THE CONSUMERS ACCESS TO THE INFORMATION, TOOLS, AND PARTS NECESSARY TO PERFORM SUCH REPAIRS; AND
- (e) Providing consumers and independent repair providers access to the information, tools, and parts necessary to perform repairs on digital electronic equipment will not hinder technological innovation, infringe upon an original equipment manufacturer's intellectual property or trade secrets, make original equipment manufacturers liable for improper repairs performed by owners or independent repair providers, or void consumers' warranties under federal law.
  - (2) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DECLARES THAT:
- (a) It is in the public interest to establish that an original equipment manufacturer's failure to provide access to the information, tools, and parts necessary to perform repairs of digital electronic equipment is an unfair or deceptive trade practice; and
- 39 (b) This part 13 should be liberally construed to achieve 40 that public interest.".

- 3 "(13) "SOURCE CODE" MEANS A TEXT LISTING OF COMMANDS TO
- 4 BE COMPILED OR ASSEMBLED INTO AN EXECUTABLE COMPUTER
- 5 PROGRAM.".
- 6 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.
- 7 Page 8, after line 21 insert:
- 8 "(4) If an owner sells digital electronic equipment, the
- 9 OWNER SHALL DISCLOSE TO ANY POTENTIAL BUYER IN WRITING, WHETHER
- 10 BY PAPER OR ELECTRONIC MEANS, THE FACT OF ANY REPAIR THAT THE
- 11 OWNER OR AN INDEPENDENT REPAIR PROVIDER PERFORMED ON THE
- 12 DIGITAL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT. THE OWNER, TO THE EXTENT
- 13 PRACTICABLE, SHALL INCLUDE IN ANY SUCH DISCLOSURE INFORMATION
- 14 REGARDING THE TYPE OF REPAIR PERFORMED, THE PERSON WHO
- 15 PERFORMED THE REPAIR, AND THE DATE THAT THE REPAIR WAS
- 16 PERFORMED.".
- 17 Page 9, line 7, strike "6-1-1303" and substitute "6-1-1304".
- Page 10, strike line 5 and substitute "PROVIDE ACCESS TO:
- 19 (I) SOURCE CODE; OR
- 20 (II) TOOL FUNCTIONS THAT ENABLE THE OWNER OR".
