<u>PURPOSE</u>: Increases appropriations by \$41.3 million General Fund in the Department of **Education**, including an increase of \$20.6 million for the Early Literacy Competitive Grant Program and an increase of \$20.6 million for Early Literacy Program Per Pupil Intervention Funding. Decreases appropriations by \$73.6 million total funds, including \$41.3 million General Fund, for **all departments** from salary survey, short term disability, amortization equalization disbursement, and supplemental amortization equalization disbursement for the elimination of the 3.0 percent across-the-board salary survey increase.
