HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 86, line 7, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL
2 column strike "4,268,016" and substitute "3,768,016" and in the
3 GENERAL FUND column strike "3,615,720" and substitute "3,115,720".

4 Adjust affected totals accordingly.

5 Page 92, line 11, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "1,779,856"
6 and substitute "1,279,856" and in the GENERAL FUND column strike
7 "1,260,331" and substitute "760,331".

8 Adjust affected totals accordingly.

9 Page 451, line 10, strike "Services" and substitute "Services^{97a}", in the
10 ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "6,541,657" and substitute
11 "7,541,657", and in the GENERAL FUND column strike "4,191,684" and
12 substitute "5,191,684".

13 Adjust affected totals accordingly.

14 Page 467, after line 15 insert:

15 97a Department of Public Safety, Division of Criminal
16 Justice, Administration, DCJ Administrative
17 Services -- It is the General Assembly's intent that,
18 of this appropriation, \$1,000,000 General Fund be
19 used by the Human Trafficking Council to explore
20 the possibility of executing, and if possible to
21 execute a human trafficking awareness campaign at
22 Denver International Airport, or to augment their
23 statewide public awareness campaign, to include
24 billboards on major highways in Colorado."

PURPOSE: Decreases appropriations in the Office of the **Governor** by \$1.0 million General Fund, including \$500,000 from the Administration of the Governor's Office and Residence and \$500,000 from the Colorado Office of Film, Television, and Media, and increases the appropriation to the Human Trafficking Council in the Department of **Public Safety**. Includes a footnote stating the General Assembly's intent for use of the funds.
