<u>PURPOSE</u>: Eliminates the \$2,464,114 General Fund appropriation to the Department of **Public Health and Environment** for the Immunization Operating Expenses line item and increases the State Share of Districts' Total Program Funding line within the Department of **Education** by the same amount. Adds a footnote stating that it is General Assembly's intent that no state funding shall be used to support the creation of vaccine passports.
