

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

BY REPRESENTATIVE Ransom

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 16, strike lines 1 through 14 and substitute:

2 "(2) (a) The participants at the precinct caucus shall also elect two
3 precinct committeepersons. Any person eighteen years of age or older
4 may be a candidate for the office of precinct committeeperson if he or she
5 has been a resident of the precinct for twenty-two days and has been
6 affiliated with the political party holding the precinct caucus for a period
7 of at least twenty-two days preceding the date of the precinct caucus;
8 except that any person who has attained the age of eighteen years or who
9 has become a naturalized citizen during the twenty-two days immediately
10 preceding the precinct caucus may be a candidate for the office of
11 precinct committeeperson even though he or she has been affiliated with
12 the political party for less than twenty-two days as shown in the statewide
13 voter registration system. IF ALLOWED BY PARTY RULES, A PERSON
14 SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER MAY BE A CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE
15 OF PRECINCT COMMITTEEPERSON IF THE PERSON IS PREREGISTERED TO
16 VOTE, HAS BEEN A RESIDENT OF THE PRECINCT FOR TWENTY-TWO DAYS
17 AND HAS BEEN AFFILIATED WITH THE POLITICAL PARTY HOLDING THE
18 PRECINCT CAUCUS FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST TWENTY-TWO DAYS
19 PRECEDING THE DATE OF THE PRECINCT CAUCUS; EXCEPT THAT A PERSON
20 WHO ATTAINED THE AGE OF SIXTEEN YEARS DURING THE TWENTY-TWO
21 DAYS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE PRECINCT CAUCUS MAY BE A
22 CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF PRECINCT COMMITTEEPERSON EVEN
23 THOUGH HE OR SHE HAS BEEN AFFILIATED WITH THE POLITICAL PARTY FOR
24 LESS THAN TWENTY-TWO DAYS AS SHOWN IN THE STATEWIDE VOTER
25 REGISTRATION SYSTEM IF ALLOWED BY PARTY RULES. The two people
