- 2 "(IX) TO REDUCE HEALTH DISPARITIES IN DISPROPORTIONATELY
3 IMPACTED COMMUNITIES RESULTING FROM INCREASED EXPOSURE TO
4 MOTOR VEHICLE FLEET EMISSIONS;".
- 5 Renumber succeeding subparagraphs accordingly.
- 6 Page 93, line 27, strike "CONGESTION" and substitute "CONGESTION,
7 ADDRESS MOBILITY, AND IMPROVE TRAVEL TIME RELIABILITY".
- 8 Page 94, lines 4 and 5, strike "IN THE AREAS WHERE THE PROJECTS ARE
9 LOCATED," and substitute "ADJACENT TO PROJECTS,".
- 10 Page 94, line 15, after "PLANNING," insert "MODELING AND OTHER".
- 11 Page 94, line 18, strike "TO,"and substitute "TO AND SHALL TO THE
12 EXTENT PRACTICABLE BE EXECUTED CONCURRENTLY WITH,".
- 13 Page 94, line 19, strike "REQUIREMENTS," and substitute "REQUIREMENTS
14 OR PROCESSES,".
- 15 Page 95, line 25, strike "THE" and substitute "EFFECTIVE AS OF JULY 1,
16 2022, THE".
- 17 Page 96, line 2, after the first "FOR" insert "REGIONALLY SIGNIFICANT".
- 18 Page 96, line 7, strike "SECTION," and substitute "SECTION AND WITH
19 OPPORTUNITIES FOR PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT,"
- 20 Page 96, line 11 and 12, strike "AS ISSUED BY THE AIR QUALITY CONTROL
21 COMMISSION" and substitute "ISSUED".
- 22 Page 96, line 21, strike "TRANSPORTATION CAPACITY PROJECTS;" and
23 substitute "REGIONALLY SIGNIFICANT TRANSPORTATION CAPACITY
24 PROJECTS ALONGSIDE TRAFFIC MODELING;".
- 25 Page 97, strike lines 4 through 16 and substitute:
- 26 "(a) USE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY APPROVED
27 MODELS TO DETERMINE AIR POLLUTANT EMISSIONS IMPACTS FOR THE

1 PLANNED PROJECT AND PROVIDE MONITORING AND MEASUREMENT OF
2 CRITERIA POLLUTANTS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION;

3 (b) DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A PARTICULATE MATTER
4 CONSTRUCTION PLAN TO PROVIDE CONTINUOUS MONITORING AND
5 TRANSPARENT PUBLIC REPORTING OF CONCENTRATIONS, PUBLIC ALERTS
6 ISSUED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE WHEN EXCEEDANCE EVENTS OCCUR, AND
7 ACTION PLANS TO ADDRESS EMISSION LEVELS ON CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS
8 PRIOR TO EXCEEDANCES WITH PARTICULAR FOCUS ON
9 DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTED COMMUNITIES; AND

10 (c) DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A PLAN TO MITIGATE AIR QUALITY
11 IMPACTS ON COMMUNITIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO
12 DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTED COMMUNITIES ADJACENT TO THE
13 PROJECT WITH PARTICULAR FOCUS WHERE FEASIBLE ON MITIGATION OF
14 FINE PARTICULATE MATTER POLLUTION.

15 (4.5) WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 270
16 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS
17 (4)(a) AND (4)(c) OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO ANY PROJECTS THAT
18 HAVE, ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2022, A SIGNED RECORD OF DECISION,
19 FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT, OR CATEGORICAL EXCLUSIONS AS
20 PROVIDED BY THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT."

21 Page 97, line 18, after "IN" insert "REGIONALLY SIGNIFICANT".

22 Page 97, line 21, strike "SHALL" and substitute "SHALL, WITH
23 OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC INPUT,".
