14 **intergovernmental agreements.** (5) (a) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS
15 THAT, DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC BEGINNING DURING THE 2019-20
16 SCHOOL YEAR, COLORADO'S PUBLIC EDUCATION SYSTEM HAS FACED
17 SIGNIFICANT DISRUPTIONS TO THE DELIVERY OF CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION,
18 STUDENT LEARNING, AND ACCESS TO CRITICALLY NECESSARY
19 NUTRITIONAL, HEALTH, AND SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL SUPPORT SERVICES.
20 THEREFORE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT:

21 (I) A WORLD-CLASS PUBLIC EDUCATION IS CRITICAL TO MEETING
22 THE WORKFORCE DEMANDS FOR COLORADO'S ECONOMY;

23 (II) THE CHANGING REALITIES OF COLORADO'S POST-PANDEMIC
24 ECONOMY DEMAND THAT STUDENTS BE AGILE LEARNERS ABLE TO
25 CONTINUOUSLY LEARN, ADAPT, AND SHIFT INTO NEW ROLES BY
26 DEVELOPING CRITICAL THINKING, COLLABORATION, AND
27 PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS; AND

28 (III) THE NEEDS OF THE STATE REQUIRE THAT ALL STUDENTS,
29 INCLUDING THOSE WHO ARE UNDERSERVED OR FACE SIGNIFICANT
30 CHALLENGES IN MEETING COLORADO'S GRADUATION GUIDELINES,
31 COMPLETE HIGH SCHOOL CAREER AND COLLEGE READY.

32 (b) TO PROVIDE EACH CHILD IN THIS STATE WITH A HIGH-QUALITY
33 PUBLIC EDUCATION, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DECLARES THAT
34 COLORADO'S PUBLIC SCHOOL FINANCE FORMULA MUST BE REDESIGNED
35 AND MODERNIZED TO:

36 (I) PRIORITIZE EQUITY, FOCUSING ON INDIVIDUAL STUDENT NEEDS

1 BY INCREASING THE FUNDING FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE ECONOMICALLY
2 DISADVANTAGED AND STUDENTS WHO ARE ENGLISH LANGUAGE
3 LEARNERS; AND
4 (II) ADDRESS THE INEQUITIES IN SCHOOL DISTRICT FUNDING THAT
5 ARISE FROM THE DRAMATIC DIFFERENCES IN LOCAL PROPERTY WEALTH
6 AND MILL LEVY OVERRIDES.
7 (c) FURTHER, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DECLARES THAT, BECAUSE
8 ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNER FUNDING WILL NOW BE INCLUDED IN THE
9 SCHOOL FINANCE FORMULA, IT IS APPROPRIATE TO FUND THIS INCLUSION
10 BY REDIRECTING TO THE STATE SHARE OF TOTAL PROGRAM THE AMOUNT
11 PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND
12 STUDENT SUPPORT PROGRAM CREATED IN SECTION 22-24-108. THE
13 GENERAL ASSEMBLY FURTHER DECLARES THAT THE REMAINING COSTS OF

5 three-year-old or four-year-old pupils with disabilities receiving
6 educational programs pursuant to article 20 of this title TITLE 22.

7 (III) "District pupils eligible for free lunch" means the number of
8 pupils included in the district pupil enrollment who are eligible for free
9 lunch pursuant to the provisions of the federal "Richard B. Russell
10 National School Lunch Act", 42 U.S.C. sec. 1751 et seq.

11 (IV) "District pupils who are English language learners" means
12 the number of pupils included in the district pupil enrollment for the
13 preceding budget year who were not eligible for free lunch pursuant to the
14 provisions of the federal "Richard B. Russell National School Lunch
15 Act", 42 U.S.C. sec. 1751 et seq., and who are English language learners,
16 as defined in section 22-24-103 (4), and:

17 (A) Whose scores were not included in calculating school
18 academic performance grades as provided in section 22-7-1006.3; or

19 (B) Who took an assessment administered pursuant to section
20 22-7-1006.3 in a language other than English.
