

## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend printed bill, page 412, line 2, strike "**EXPENSES**<sup>96</sup>" and  
 2 substitute "**EXPENSES**<sup>96,96a</sup>", in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike  
 3 "53,237,283" and substitute "50,773,169" and in the GENERAL FUND  
 4 column strike "2,464,114".

5 Adjust affected totals accordingly.

6 Page 456, after line 14 insert:

7       "96a Department of Public Health and Environment,  
 8       Disease Control and Public Health Response,  
 9       General Disease Control and Surveillance,  
 10       Immunization Operating Expenses -- The General  
 11       Fund in this line item is \$2,464,114 less than the  
 12       amount appropriated in S.B. 21-205. It is the  
 13       General Assembly's intent that the savings of  
 14       \$2,464,114 be returned to Colorado taxpayers."

**PURPOSE:** Removes \$2.5 million General Fund to the Immunization Operating Expenses line item for the Colorado Immunization Information System within the Department of **Public Health and Environment**. Adds a footnote stating the General Assembly's intent the General Fund savings be returned to taxpayers.
