4	23-20-145. Actuarial cost study of the costs associated with
5	enforcement of drug laws and incarceration for drug crimes - repeal.
6	(1) Beginning by September 1, 2023, the Colorado school of
7	PUBLIC HEALTH SHALL CONDUCT AN ACTUARIAL COST STUDY EVALUATING
8	THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ENFORCEMENT OF DRUG LAWS AND
9	INCARCERATION IN THE STATE.
10	(2) THE ACTUARIAL COST STUDY MUST:
11	(a) Consider and determine state and local government
12	COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF DRUG
13	CRIMES;
14	(b) Consider and determine the costs incurred by the
15	JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT TO ADJUDICATE DRUG CRIMES AND TO SUPERVISE
16	DEFENDANTS CONVICTED OF DRUG CRIMES;
17	(c) Consider and determine state and local government
18	COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH CONFINEMENT AND INCARCERATION OF
19	INDIVIDUALS ACCUSED OF AND CONVICTED OF DRUG CRIMES AND THE
20	STATE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PAROLE SUPERVISION FOR THOSE
21	CONVICTED OF DRUG CRIMES;
22	(d) DETERMINE THE TOTAL STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT COSTS
23	ASSOCIATED WITH ENFORCEMENT OF DRUG LAWS; INVESTIGATION OF AND
24	PUNISHMENT FOR DRUG CRIMES, INCLUDING COSTS FOR TREATMENT
25	RECOVERY SERVICES, IF NEEDED, RELATED TO DRUG USE; AND
26	REHABILITATION OF THOSE CONVICTED OF DRUG CRIMES.
27	(3) THE COLORADO SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH SHALL PROVIDE
28	THE ACTUARIAL COST STUDY TO THE EVALUATING THE COSTS ASSOCIATED
29	WITH ENFORCEMENT OF DRUG LAWS AND INCARCERATION FOR DRUG
30	CRIMES TASK FORCE CREATED IN SECTION 25-1.5-120 BY FEBRUARY 15,
31	2024.
32	(4) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2025.".
