SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Health & Human Services.

SB23-260 be amended as follows:

1 Amend proposed committee amendment (SB260_L.011), page 1, after
2 line 13, insert:

3 "(II) A PRACTITIONER, EXCEPT FOR AN INDEPENDENT PHARMACY,
4 AS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION, WHO ADMINISTERS A
5 PUBLICLY FUNDED VACCINE SHALL POST AND KEEP POSTED A NOTICE
6 PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT,
7 IN MULTIPLE LANGUAGES IF REQUESTED, THAT CONFIRMS THAT THE
8 PUBLICLY FUNDED VACCINE WILL BE PROVIDED REGARDLESS OF THE
9 INDIVIDUAL'S ABILITY TO PAY A VACCINE ADMINISTRATION FEE.

10 (III) A NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION (2) MUST BE POSTED
11 BY THE PRACTITIONER IN A LOCATION CONSPICUOUS TO THE INDIVIDUAL,
12 OR A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN CONSENTING TO THE VACCINATION OF
13 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE, AT THE LOCATION
14 OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S APPOINTMENT. EACH PRACTITIONER SHALL TAKE
15 STEPS TO ENSURE THAT THE NOTICE IS NOT ALTERED, DEFACED, OR
16 COVERED BY OTHER MATERIAL.

17 (c) A PRACTITIONER, EXCEPT FOR AN INDEPENDENT PHARMACY AS
18 DEFINED IN SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION, SHALL PROVIDE THE
19 INDIVIDUAL, OR A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN CONSENTING TO THE
20 VACCINATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE,
21 WITH A DISCLOSURE STATEMENT IN THE LANGUAGE UNDERSTOOD BY THE
22 INDIVIDUAL RECEIVING THE VACCINE OR THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN
23 CONSENTING TO THE VACCINATION OF AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER EIGHTEEN
24 YEARS OF AGE, THAT CONFIRMS THAT THE PUBLICLY FUNDED VACCINE
25 WILL BE PROVIDED REGARDLESS OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S PROVISION OF THE
26 REQUESTED DOCUMENTATION OR OF PAYMENT OF A VACCINE
27 ADMINISTRATION FEE."
