- (9) (b) The courts of record of this state shall have jurisdiction to issue injunctions to enforce the purposes of this section upon application by any citizen of this state. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (9)(c) OF THIS SECTION, in any action in which the court finds a violation of this section, the court shall award the citizen prevailing in such action costs and reasonable attorney fees. In the event the court does not find a violation of this section, it shall award costs and reasonable attorney fees to the prevailing party if the court finds that the action was frivolous, vexatious, or groundless.
- (c) A PRO SE PLAINTIFF IN AN ACTION CHALLENGING A LOCAL PUBLIC BODY FOR A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (2)(d.5)(II) OR (4) OF THIS SECTION OR FOR A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (2)(d)(II) OF THIS SECTION ONLY AS IT RELATES TO AN EXECUTIVE SESSION HELD AT A MEETING, IS NOT ENTITLED TO AN AWARD OF COSTS OR ATTORNEY FEES, NOR MAY COSTS OR ATTORNEY FEES BE ASSESSED AGAINST A PRO SE PLAINTIFF UNLESS OTHERWISE ALLOWED BY SUBSECTION (9)(b) OF THIS SECTION.".
