

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

HB23-1107 be amended as follows:

1 Strike the Judiciary Committee Report, dated March 1, 2023, and
2 substitute:

3 "Amend page 2 of the printed bill, strike lines 2 through 20.

4 Page 3 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 16.

5 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

6 Page 4 of the bill, strike lines 18 through 27.

7 Page 5 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 12.

8 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

9 Page 6 of the bill, line 15, strike "2023-24" and substitute "2024-25".

10 Page 6 of the bill, line 17, strike SEVEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED
11 THOUSAND" and substitute "THREE MILLION".

12 Page 6 of the bill, after line 20, insert:

13 "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-32-120, **add**
14 (1)(c)(V) as follows:

15 **24-32-120. Justice reinvestment crime prevention initiative -**
16 **program - rules - cash funds - reports - repeal.** (1) (c) (V) (A) ON
17 JULY 1, 2024, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER ALL UNEXPENDED
18 AND UNENCUMBERED MONEY IN THE FUND TO THE STATE DOMESTIC
19 VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT SERVICES FUND CREATED IN SECTION
20 26-7.5-105 (4).

21 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-20.5-801, **amend**
22 (9)(e) as follows:

23 **25-20.5-801. Community crime victims grant program -**
24 **created - cash fund - repeal.** (9) (e) The state treasurer shall transfer all
25 unexpended and unencumbered money in the fund on ~~September 1, 2024,~~
26 AUGUST 31, 2023, to the general fund.

27 **SECTION 5. Effective date.** This act takes effect upon passage;
28 except that section 4 of this act takes effect only if Senate Bill 23-160
29 does not become law."
