Second Reading

1 Amend printed bill, page 23, strike line 25 and substitute "(1)(b.5)(I)
2 introductory portion and (1)(b.7); and **repeal**".

3 Page 25, strike lines 1 through 6.

4 Page 41, line 11, strike "CALLS OR".

5 Page 41, strike lines 12 and 13 and substitute "CALLS, EXCEPT FOR CALLS
6 TO OR FROM THE MULTILINGUAL BALLOT HOTLINE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT
7 TO SECTION 1-5-904, OR TAKE ANY PICTURES OR VIDEOS OTHER THAN
8 IMAGES OF THE ELECTOR'S OWN PERSON OR BALLOT."

9 Page 48, line 12, strike "(4.3)(a)(II),".

10 Page 49, strike lines 19 through. 27.

11 Page 50, strike lines 1 through 16 and substitute:

12 "(II) THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER OR DESIGNATED
13 ELECTION OFFICIAL, WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS OF RECEIVING AN
14 ELIGIBLE ELECTOR'S IDENTIFICATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION
15 (3.5)(b) OF THIS SECTION, SHALL UPDATE THE STATEWIDE VOTER
16 REGISTRATION SYSTEM TO INDICATE THAT THE ELIGIBLE ELECTOR HAS
17 CURED THE DEFICIENCY ON THEIR BALLOT. THE CLERK AND RECORDER OR
18 DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL IS NOT REQUIRED TO UPDATE THE
19 STATEWIDE VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION
20 (3.5)(d)(II) ON A SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR LEGAL HOLIDAY UNLESS, ON
21 THE THURSDAY IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING ELECTION DAY, THE CLERK AND
22 RECORDER OR DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL'S REVIEW OF THE
23 REMAINING NUMBER OF LETTERS ISSUED BUT NOT RETURNED PURSUANT
24 TO SUBSECTION (3.5)(d)(I) OF THIS SECTION AND SECTIONS 1-7.5-107.3
25 (1.5)(a) AND 1-7.5-107.3 (2)(a) INDICATES THAT THE MARGIN FOR ANY
26 BALLOT CONTEST OR BALLOT QUESTION IS GREATER THAN THE REMAINING
27 NUMBER OF LETTERS ISSUED OR INDICATES THAT THE REMAINING NUMBER
28 OF LETTERS ISSUED TO VOTERS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE ON A PARTICULAR
29 BALLOT CONTEST OR BALLOT QUESTION COULD NOT POTENTIALLY MOVE
30 THE MARGIN OF THAT BALLOT CONTEST OR BALLOT QUESTION INTO A
31 MANDATORY RECOUNT PURSUANT TO SECTION 1-10.5-101 (1)(b), IF
32 RETURNED.

33 (III) FOR STATE-CERTIFIED BALLOT CONTESTS AND BALLOT
34 MEASURES, THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE SHALL COMPLETE THE
35 REVIEW PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (4.3)(a)(II) OF THIS SECTION."

2 Page 53, strike lines 1 through 14 and substitute:

4 COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER OR DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL,
5 WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS OF RECEIVING THE ELIGIBLE ELECTOR'S
6 SIGNED FORM AND IDENTIFICATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION
7 (1.5)(b) OF THIS SECTION, SHALL UPDATE THE STATEWIDE VOTER
8 REGISTRATION SYSTEM TO INDICATE THAT THE ELIGIBLE ELECTOR HAS

19 OF LETTERS ISSUED TO VOTERS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE ON A PARTICULAR
20 BALLOT CONTEST OR BALLOT QUESTION COULD NOT POTENTIALLY MOVE
21 THE MARGIN OF THAT BALLOT CONTEST OR BALLOT QUESTION INTO A

24 (II) FOR STATE-CERTIFIED BALLOT CONTESTS AND BALLOT

26 REVIEW PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1.5)(d)(I) OF THIS SECTION.

27 (2) (d) (I) THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER OR DESIGNATED
28 ELECTION OFFICIAL, WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS OF RECEIVING AN
29 ELIGIBLE ELECTOR'S SIGNED FORM AND IDENTIFICATION IN COMPLIANCE
30 WITH SUBSECTION (2)(a) OF THIS SECTION, SHALL UPDATE THE STATEWIDE
31 VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM TO INDICATE THAT THE ELIGIBLE ELECTOR
32 HAS CURED THE DEFICIENCY ON THEIR BALLOT. THE CLERK AND RECORDER
33 OR DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL IS NOT REQUIRED TO UPDATE THE
34 STATEWIDE VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION
35 (2)(d) ON A SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR LEGAL HOLIDAY UNLESS, ON THE
36 THURSDAY IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING ELECTION DAY, THE CLERK AND
37 RECORDER OR DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL'S REVIEW OF THE
38 REMAINING NUMBER OF LETTERS ISSUED BUT NOT RETURNED PURSUANT
