Committee on Legal Services.

SB23-102 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, strike lines 5 through 10 and substitute:

2 "(n) Department of public health and environment;"

3 Page 3, line 12, after "agencies;" add "except that the following rules are
