

SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

BY SENATORS Cutter and Priola

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 13, line 20, strike "(I)".

2 Page 13, strike lines 25 through 27.

3 Page 14, strike lines 1 through 9 and substitute:

4 "(d) (I) MEMBERS SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR ACTUAL AND
5 NECESSARY EXPENSES INCURRED WHILE PERFORMING OFFICIAL DUTIES,
6 TOGETHER WITH MILEAGE, AT THE RATE AT WHICH MEMBERS OF THE
7 GENERAL ASSEMBLY ARE REIMBURSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-2-317.
8 ALL CONSORTIUM MEMBERS ARE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE FIFTY DOLLARS
9 FOR EACH MEETING ATTENDED DURING THE 2023-24 STATE FISCAL YEAR;
10 EXCEPT THAT MEMBERS WHO ARE APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION
11 (3)(a)(IV)(B) OF THIS SECTION AND RESIDE IN A DISPROPORTIONATELY
12 IMPACTED COMMUNITY ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL ONE
13 HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS FOR EACH MEETING ATTENDED DURING THE
14 2023-24 STATE FISCAL YEAR.

15 (II) A MEMBER OF THE CONSORTIUM WHO, AS PART OF THE
16 MEMBER'S TYPICALLY ASSIGNED, REGULAR JOB DUTIES, RECEIVES
17 PROFESSIONAL COMPENSATION FOR THE MEMBER'S PARTICIPATION IN A
18 CONSORTIUM MEETING IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE ADDITIONAL PER DIEM
19 FOR REPRESENTATIVES OF A DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTED COMMUNITY
20 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (3)(d)(I) OF THIS SECTION.

21 (III) THE DIRECTOR OF THE CONSORTIUM HIRED PURSUANT TO
22 SUBSECTION (3)(e) OF THIS SECTION SHALL ANNUALLY ADJUST THE PER
23 DIEM AMOUNTS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (3)(d)(I) OF THIS SECTION
24 BASED ON THE ANNUAL PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN THE UNITED STATES
25 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR'S BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS CONSUMER PRICE
26 INDEX FOR DENVER-AURORA-LAKEWOOD FOR ALL ITEMS PAID BY ALL
27 URBAN CONSUMERS, OR ITS SUCCESSOR INDEX.

28 (IV) THE DIRECTOR OF THE CONSORTIUM SHALL DETERMINE THE
29 FORM AND MANNER BY WHICH A CONSORTIUM MEMBER MAY REQUEST
30 EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT, MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT, OR A PER DIEM
31 ALLOWANCE."
