HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

HB23-1300 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 8, line 22, strike "SECTION." and substitute
2 "SECTION, AND TO CONTINUE ENROLLMENT FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH NO
3 INCOME, AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (7)(d) OF THIS SECTION."

4 Page 8, line 24, strike "CHILD IS".

5 Page 8, strike lines 25 through 27.

6 Page 9, strike line 1, and substitute "CHILD IS AS DEFINED IN ARTICLES 2,
7 3, 5, 6, AND 8 OF THIS TITLE 25.5, INCLUDING A CHILD ELIGIBLE PURSUANT
8 TO SECTIONS 25.5-2-104 AND 25.5-2-105, AND MUST BE UNDER THREE
9 YEARS OF AGE."

10 Page 9, after line 24, insert:

11 "(d) TO FACILITATE THE RENEWAL PROCESS FOR THE MEDICAL
12 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH NO INCOME, INCLUDING
13 THOSE WHO ARE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS, THE STATE DEPARTMENT
14 SHALL SEEK FEDERAL AUTHORIZATION, TO THE EXTENT ALLOWABLE BY
15 THE CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES, TO COMPLETE THE
16 INCOME DETERMINATION FOR EX PARTE RENEWALS WITHOUT REQUESTING
17 ADDITIONAL INCOME INFORMATION OR DOCUMENTATION, IF:

18 (I) AN ATTESTATION OF ZERO-DOLLAR INCOME WAS VERIFIED
19 WITHIN THE LAST TWELVE MONTHS, AT THE INITIAL APPLICATION, OR THE
20 PREVIOUS RENEWAL; AND

21 (II) THE STATE DEPARTMENT HAS CHECKED FINANCIAL DATA
22 SOURCES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION PLAN AS
23 REQUIRED BY THE CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES AND
24 NO INFORMATION IS RECEIVED."

25 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.
