1 Amend printed bill, page 2, after line 1 insert:

"SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. (1) The general assembly hereby finds and declares that:

- (a) The Taxpayer's Bill of Rights (TABOR), codified at Section 20 of Article X of the Colorado Constitution, was adopted by voter initiative in 1992. TABOR codifies various rules that place the taxing power directly in the hands of the people, limiting the power of the state and its political subdivisions to raise revenue.
- (b) TABOR requires the governor, the general assembly, and local governments to be responsible stewards of taxpayer dollars by prioritizing funding for core government functions;
- (c) Even with TABOR in place, total state appropriations per Coloradan, adjusted for inflation, have increased by 57% over the last 20 years, from \$3,304 to \$5,196, allowing the state to meet the demands stemming from population growth and an evolving economic landscape, while continuing to prioritize taxpayers over ineffectual government growth;
- (d) Colorado voters have repeatedly rejected numerous efforts to repeal TABOR since its enactment. As recently as November 2020, voters rejected efforts to significantly overhaul or repeal TABOR; and
- (e) Given the historic budget surpluses the state is experiencing, the general assembly finds it necessary to implement TABOR refunds as soon as possible in order to support working families across the state by returning tax dollars to them.".
