

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Finance.

SB23-291 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 14, strike lines 23 through 27 and substitute
2 "TO:

3 (a) DETERMINE WHETHER ALTERNATIVE INFRASTRUCTURE,
4 SERVICE INVESTMENTS, OR OTHER UTILITY ACTIONS COULD MITIGATE
5 IMPACTS ON NONPARTICIPATING OR INCOME-QUALIFIED CUSTOMERS IN A
6 MANNER THAT IS NECESSARY, APPROPRIATE, AND COULD HELP REDUCE
7 GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS IN ALIGNMENT WITH THE "COLORADO
8 GREENHOUSE GAS POLLUTION REDUCTION ROADMAP", PUBLISHED BY THE
9 COLORADO ENERGY OFFICE; AND

10 (b) IDENTIFY THE UP-FRONT AND SERVICE LIFE ANNUALIZED COSTS
11 AND BENEFITS OF THE ALTERNATIVES IDENTIFIED IN SUBSECTION (2)(a) OF
12 THIS SECTION."

13 Page 15, after line 20 insert:

14 "(b) THE COMMISSION MAY REQUIRE A GAS UTILITY TO PROVIDE ITS
15 CUSTOMERS WITH RELEVANT INFORMATION REGARDING OPTIONS FOR
16 SWITCHING TO HIGH-EFFICIENCY ELECTRIC SPACE HEATING OR WATER
17 HEATING, INCLUDING:

18 (I) A LIST OF APPLIANCES, FOR WHICH THE UTILITY PROVIDES
19 INCENTIVES OR REBATES; AND

20 (II) FOR EXISTING OR PROSPECTIVE CUSTOMERS WITH FACILITIES
21 LARGER THAN FIFTY THOUSAND SQUARE FEET, A COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS
22 OF ELECTRIFICATION OPTIONS THAT INCLUDES UP-FRONT AND LIFETIME
23 COSTS, WHICH ANALYSIS MUST TAKE INTO ACCOUNT AVAILABLE
24 INCENTIVES AND REBATES AND USE A REASONABLE COST THAT REFLECTS
25 GAS PRICE VOLATILITY."

26 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

27 Page 15, line 25, strike "(2)(b)" and substitute "(2)(c)".

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
