"SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 5-2-201, amend (2) as follows:

5-2-201. Finance charge for consumer credit transactions definition. (2) (a) With respect to a supervised loan or a consumer credit sale, except for a loan or sale pursuant to a revolving account, a supervised lender or seller may contract for and receive a finance charge, calculated according to the actuarial method, not exceeding the equivalent of the greater of either of the following:
(a) (I) The total of:
( $\ddagger$ (A) Thirty-six percent per year on that part of the unpaid balances of the amount financed that is one Three thousand dollars or less;
(H) (B) Twenty-one percent per year plus A margin EQUAL To THE FEDERAL FUNDS RATE on that part of the unpaid balances of the amount financed that is more than one THREE thousand dollars but does not exceed three FIVE thousand dollars; and
(円⿴) (C) Fifteen percent per year PLUS A MARGIN EQUAL TO THE FEDERAL FUNDS RATE on that part of the unpaid balances of the amount financed that is more than three FIVE thousand dollars; or
(b) (II) Twenty-one percent per year on the unpaid balances of the amount financed FOR LOANS THAT ARE MORE THAN THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS.
(b) This SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO SUPERVISED LENDERS AND STATE CHARTERED BANK SUPERVISED FINANCIAL ORGANIZATIONS THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THE ASSURANCE OF discontinuance, Dated August 7, 2020, in the matters of Avant of Colorado, LLC, and Marlette Funding, LLC.
(c) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "FEDERAL FUNDS RATE" MEANS THE RATE PUBLISHED BY THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE SYSTEM IN ITS STATISTICAL RELEASE "H. 15 -Selected Interest Rates" AND IN EFFECT AS OF THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE MONTH DURING WHICH THE LOAN IS CONSUMMATED.".
