1 Amend printed bill, page 6, after line 24 insert:

2 "(3) (a) EMPLOYERS, GOVERNING BOARDS, AND PUBLIC
3 ADMINISTRATORS AT ALL TIMES HAVE THE RIGHT TO SHARE THEIR FRANK
4 AND FREE OPINIONS ON THE ADVANTAGES OR DISADVANTAGES OF
5 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR.

6 (b) PUBLIC EMPLOYERS HAVE ALL POWERS, DUTIES, AND RIGHTS
7 ESTABLISHED BY CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISION, STATUTE, ORDINANCE,
8 CHARTER, SPECIAL ACT, OR OTHER PROVISIONS OF LAW OR ORGANIC
9 ORGANIZING DOCUMENTS OF THE PUBLIC BODY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
10 LIMITED TO, THE RIGHT TO DIRECT THE WORK OF EMPLOYEES; HIRE,
11 PROMOTE, DEMOTE, FIRE, ASSIGN, TRANSFER, AND OTHERWISE DIRECT
12 EMPLOYEES; SUSPEND EMPLOYEES FOR PURPOSES OF INVESTIGATION OR
13 DISCIPLINE, AND DISCIPLINE OR DISCHARGE EMPLOYEES, AS OTHERWISE
14 PERMITTED BY LAW; MAINTAIN AND PROMOTE GOVERNMENTAL
15 EFFICIENCY; LAY OFF EMPLOYEES FOR LACK OF WORK OR PERFORMANCE;
16 ASSIDUOUSLY PURSUE THE LAWFUL MISSION OF THE PUBLIC ENTITY AND
17 SEEK TO PROVIDE THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC;
18 DETERMINE AND IMPLEMENT A PRUDENT BUDGET; CONSERVE PUBLIC
19 RESOURCES; AND OTHERWISE EXERCISE ALL INHERENT MANAGEMENT
20 POWERS AND DUTIES GRANTED OR IMPLIED BY LAW."
