- 4 Page 18, line 5, strike "0.4 FTE" and substitute "0.9 FTE".
- 5 Page 18, line 6, strike "\$58,165" and substitute "\$108,961".
- 6 Page 18, after line 6 insert:
 - "(2) Of the money appropriated under subsection (1)(b) of this section not expended prior to July 1, 2024, \$75,000 is further appropriated to the department for the 2024-25 state fiscal year.
 - (3) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, \$60,358 is appropriated to the department of health care policy and financing for use by the executive director's office. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation as follows:
 - (a) \$52,608 for personal services, which amount is based on an assumption that the office will require an additional 1.6 FTE; and
 - (b) \$7,750 for operating expenses.
 - (4) For the 2023-24 state fiscal year, the general assembly anticipates that the department of health care policy and financing will receive \$60,358 in federal funds to implement this act, which amount is subject to the "(I)" notation as defined in the annual general appropriation act for the same fiscal year. The appropriation in subsection (2) of this section is based on the assumption that the department will receive this amount of federal funds to be used as follows:
 - (a) \$52,608 for personal services; and
 - (b) \$7,750 for operating expenses.".
