1 Amend the Business Affairs and Labor Committee Report, dated March
2 23, 2023, page 2, line 18, ~~after~~ strike "APPLICATIONS;". and substitute
3 "APPLICATIONS; EXCEPT THAT AN OPERATOR IS NOT REQUIRED TO NOTIFY
4 THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE USE OF SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS FOR
5 EVENT TICKET SALES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (1)(d);".

6 Page 2, strike lines 22 through 33, and substitute:

7 " (I) (I) FAILS TO CLEARLY AND CONSPICUOUSLY DISCLOSE ON A
8 WEBSITE BEING UTILIZED FOR THE ORIGINAL SALE OF TICKETS TO AN
9 EVENT:

10 (A) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF TICKETS THAT WILL BE OFFERED FOR
11 SALE TO THE EVENT NOT LESS THAN ONE DAY BEFORE THE DATE ON WHICH
12 THE TICKETS ARE MADE AVAILABLE FOR SALE;

13 (B) WHETHER ADDITIONAL TICKETS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR
14 SALE AT A LATER DATE;

15 (C) AN HOURLY UPDATE REGARDING THE NUMBER OF TICKETS
16 STILL AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC FOR PURCHASE;

17 (D) FOR TICKETS DISCLOSED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION
18 (1)(I)(A) OF THIS SECTION, THE PRICE OF THOSE TICKETS, INCLUDING
19 THE NUMBER AND TOTAL COST OF TICKETS OFFERED AT A SET PRICE; AND

20 (E) THE NUMBER OF TICKETS WITH PRICES THAT WILL FLUCTUATE
21 TO REFLECT MARKET DEMAND.

22 (II) THE OPERATOR OF A PLACE OF ENTERTAINMENT THAT HAS A
23 CAPACITY OF TWO THOUSAND PEOPLE OR FEWER IS NOT REQUIRED TO
24 MAKE THE DISCLOSURES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1)(I)(I) OF THIS
25 SECTION.".
