    - (B) WHETHER ADDITIONAL TICKETS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR SALE AT A LATER DATE;
- 15 (C) AN HOURLY UPDATE REGARDING THE NUMBER OF TICKETS STILL AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC FOR PURCHASE;
  - (D) FOR TICKETS DISCLOSED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(1)(1)(A) of this section, the price of those tickets, including the number and total cost of tickets offered at a set price; and
  - (E) THE NUMBER OF TICKETS WITH PRICES THAT WILL FLUCTUATE TO REFLECT MARKET DEMAND.
- 22 (II) THE OPERATOR OF A PLACE OF ENTERTAINMENT THAT HAS A
  23 CAPACITY OF TWO THOUSAND PEOPLE OR FEWER IS NOT REQUIRED TO
  24 MAKE THE DISCLOSURES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1)(1)(I) OF THIS
  25 SECTION.".".
