1 Amend printed bill, page 78, after line 3 insert:

"SECTION 83. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-45-111.5, add (6) as follows:

1-45-111.5. Duties of the secretary of state - enforcement - sanctions - definitions. (6) (a) The secretary of state shall appoint and designate persons, in accordance with this subsection (6), to serve as administrative law judges with respect to any complaint that is filed alleging a violation of article XXVIII of the state constitution or this article 45. The secretary of state shall appoint the administrative law judges in the following manner:

- (I) NOT LATER THAN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (6), THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL APPOINT TWO PERSONS WHO WILL COMPRISE A RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE TO ASSIST THE SECRETARY IN APPOINTING PERSONS AS ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (6). EACH APPOINTEE TO THE RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE MUST HAVE BEEN AFFILIATED FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS WITH A MAJOR POLITICAL PARTY. THE TWO MEMBERS OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE SHALL NOT BE AFFILIATED WITH THE SAME MAJOR POLITICAL PARTY.
- (II) NOT LATER THAN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THEIR APPOINTMENT BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE, THE MEMBERS OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE SHALL SOLICIT, BY MEANS OF A NOTICE PLACED ON THE WEBSITE OF THE SECRETARY, A LIST OF CANDIDATES TO BE CONSIDERED FOR APPOINTMENT AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE.
- (III) NOT LATER THAN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE POSTING OF THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (6)(a)(II) OF THIS SECTION, THE RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE SHALL POST ON THE WEBSITE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE A LIST OF THE CANDIDATES TO BE CONSIDERED FOR APPOINTMENT AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE. BY ADDITIONAL NOTICE PLACED ON THE WEBSITE, THE RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE SHALL REQUEST PUBLIC COMMENTS ON THE CANDIDATES LISTED.
- (IV) NOT LATER THAN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE POSTING OF THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (6)(a)(III) OF THIS SECTION REQUESTING PUBLIC COMMENTS, THE RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE SHALL RECOMMEND TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE THREE CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE.
- 38 (V) NOT LATER THAN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE 39 RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE SUBMITS ITS RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE 40 SECRETARY OF STATE PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (6)(a)(IV) OF THIS

- SECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT THREE PERSONS FROM THE LIST OF CANDIDATES SUBMITTED BY THE RECOMMENDATIONS COMMITTEE TO SERVE AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE. OF THE THREE PERSONS APPOINTED INITIALLY, THE TERM OF OFFICE OF ONE PERSON APPOINTED WILL BE TWO YEARS, THE TERM OF OFFICE OF ONE PERSON APPOINTED WILL BE THREE YEARS, AND THE TERM OF OFFICE OF ONE PERSON APPOINTED WILL BE FOUR YEARS. AFTER THE INITIAL THREE APPOINTMENTS ARE MADE, THE TERM OF OFFICE OF PERSONS APPOINTED AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (6) IS THREE YEARS.
 - (b) EACH ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE APPOINTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (6)(a) OF THIS SECTION MUST BE AN ATTORNEY WITH AT LEAST FIVE YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE PRACTICE OF LAW.
 - (c) If at any time the two members of the recommendations committee are not able to agree on a list of three candidates to recommend to the secretary of state as required by subsection (6)(a)(IV) of this section, the secretary shall discharge the existing recommendations committee and appoint a new recommendations committee following the same procedures as specified in subsection (6)(a)(I) of this section.
 - (d) Each administrative law judge appointed pursuant to this subsection (6) is authorized to administer oaths, examine witnesses, issue subpoenas, receive evidence, conduct hearings, and exercise any other powers and duties that are delegated to administrative law judges under article XXVIII of the state constitution or this article 45.
 - (e) Not later than January 1, 2024, the secretary of state shall establish and maintain a program to train administrative law judges appointed pursuant to subsection (6)(a) of this section to undertake their powers and duties as provided by law. The training program must be approved by the recommendations committee.".
