

SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

- 1 Amend the Appropriations Committee Report, page 2, strike lines 1
2 through 12 and substitute:
- 3 **""SECTION 3. Appropriation.** (1) (a) For the 2023-24 state
4 fiscal year, \$84,000,000 is appropriated to a department as defined by
5 section 24-75-232 (2)(a), C.R.S., and to the office of the governor for use
6 by a department or the office of the governor. This appropriation is from
7 the "Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act" cash fund created in section
8 24-75-232 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act, a department or the office
9 of the governor may use this appropriation as follows:
- 10 (I) \$30,000,000 for water programs in coordination with local
11 governments to replace lead lines, increase funds for the eliminations of
12 harmful chemicals and particulates in drinking water, and other water
13 projects;
- 14 (II) \$1,500,000 for phase 1 of Hydrogen Hubs, the four-state
15 partnership with neighboring states to design, construct, and deliver a
16 hydrogen hub facility for alternative energy;
- 17 (III) \$10,000,000 for additional resources to support match needs
18 for local and tribal agencies applying directly for projects that are not
19 eligible for the state;
- 20 (IV) \$24,500,000 to increase broadband access to hard to connect
21 rural areas and historically left behind areas; and
- 22 (V) \$18,000,000 for match needs on transportation projects that
23 are identified in the ten-year plan described in section 43-1-106 (15)(d).
- 24 (b) Any money appropriated in this section not expended prior to
25 July 1, 2024, is further appropriated to a department and the office of the
26 governor through the 2026-27 state fiscal year for the same purpose."."
